## **SEA GAS SIGNS OPERATION & MAINTENANCE SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR THE MORTLAKE PIPELINE**

SEA Gas has entered into an agreement with Origin Energy (Origin), to provide operating and maintenance services for the yet to be commissioned Origin's Mortlake Pipeline (OMP). The OMP is approximately 80 kilometres in length, receiving gas from the SEA Gas pipeline system at Iona and delivering it to Origin's power station based near Mortlake Victoria. In providing these services SEA Gas will be supported by its maintenance service provider, APA Group.

SEA Gas General Manager Ashley Kellett said, "Origin is a long term customer of SEA Gas and SEA Gas is pleased to be able to provide these services. The successful conclusion of these negotiations is an example of SEA Gas building on its in-house expertise and industry knowledge.

"SEA Gas looks forward to exploring other growth opportunities in transportation and related services where there is a sensible fit to SEA Gas' business model," he said.
